SCENE A

FADE IN:

INT. DAVE AND PATRICK'S DORMATORY - NOON (DAY 1)

(Dave, Patrick, Diane, Tiffiny)

(DAVE ENTERS THE DORMATORY WHILE PATRICK IS WATCHING AN EPISODE OF "THE PRICE IS RIGHT")

DAVE

Mail Call.

PATRICK

SHHH! Rod Roddy is about to

introduce Bob Barker.

(DAVE STANDS QUIETLY AS WE HEAR ROD RODDY'S VOICE ON THE TELEVISION)

ROD RODDY (O.C.)

Here's the star of "The Price Is Right,"

Bob Barker!

DAVE

Okay, may I talk now?

PATRICK

(TURNS OFF TELEVISION)

Sure Dave. What's up?

DAVE

Mail Call.

(DAVE HANDS PATRICK AN ENVELOPE)

(EXCITED)

YES!

DAVE

What is it?

PATRICK

These are our tickets to glory
man! Four tickets to go see

Bob, Rod, and that hot model

Nikki on "The Price Is Right!"

DAVE

Awesome! Why did you get four tickets, though?

PATRICK

The show has a minimum of four tickets only. We will have to invite two people to come with us. Just think, if I get up on stage, I can go for my dream showcase.

DAVE

What is that?

A trip to New York in a nice hotel, and some nice dancing lessons, because I want to learn to dance.

DAVE

Do you know how much that would cost?

PATRICK

Oh yeah, I know it by heart.

DAVE

Kind of like my dream showcase,
right?

PATRICK

What do you mean?

DAVE

A trip to the Indy 500, and a new car. Well, who are you going to invite?

PATRICK

I don't know. I have been thinking about it since I ordered them.

(SFX: DOOR KNOCK)

DIANE

Hey guys, what's happening?

PATRICK

(TO DAVE)

(IMPERSONATING ROD RODDY)

Diane, come on down!

DIANE

(TO DAVE)

What is he talking about?

DAVE

Our friend Patrick here

decided he wants to be

famous, so he ordered

tickets to go see "The

Price Is Right."

DIANE

(TO PATRICK)

What's "The Price Is Right?"

I never heard of it.

PATRICK

(TO DIANE)

What?!? Are you insane?

DAVE

(TO DIANE)

That's like saying that

you've never heard of the

"Family Feud!"

DIANE

(TO DAVE)

Is it a game show?

PATRICK

Yes.

DIANE

(TO PATRICK)

Sounds like fun! When is

the taping?

PATRICK

Next Tuesday at eight o'clock

in the morning.

DIANE

I won't be able to make it

because I have a test that

day.

(TO DAVE)

Well, we could always ask

Tiffiny and Katie.

DAVE

This is true.

DIANE

So, what are you guys

doing for lunch?

DAVE

(TO DIANE)

Well, Tiffiny is supposed

to come over and eat lunch

with us. You are welcome

to join.

DIANE

Sounds like fun. When is

she going to be here?

(SFX: DOOR KNOCK)

TIFFINY

(WALKS TOWARDS DAVE)

Hey sexy!

(KISSES DAVE)

DAVE

Hey Tiffiny, how is my

favorite girlfriend?

TIFFINY

(TO DAVE)

I don't know, why don't

you ask her?

(DAVE LAUGHS)

Who's hungry besides me?

PATRICK

Well, Dave is always hungry!

(EVERYONE LAUGHS)

DAVE

(TO TIFFINY)

Babe, how would you like

to go see "The Price Is Right?"

TIFFINY

(TO DAVE)

I'm game! When and where?

PATRICK

Next Tuesday in the Bob Barker

Studio in Hollywood!

TIFFINY

(TO PATRICK)

How are we getting there?

PATRICK

Dave has the hookup on a plane.

TIFFINY

(TO DAVE)

Oh really?

DAVE

(TO TIFFINY)

I have an uncle that flies
airplanes for Delta Airlines,
and he's giving us free round
trip tickets to go to the show.

TIFFINY

(TO DAVE)

That's awesome! Wait! First-class, right?

DAVE

Well, not exactly. He can only get us coach tickets.

TIFFINY

Well, it will get us to the taping right?

DAVE

This is true! Let's go eat!

(AS EVERYONE WALKS OUT OF THE ROOM, WE:)

DISSOLVE TO:

SCENE B

INT. DAVE AND PATRICK'S DORMATORY - LATER THAT DAY

(DAVE, PATRICK, TIFFINY, KATIE)

(PATRICK IS READING A STACK OF STORE ADVERTISEMENTS AS DAVE ENTERS)

DAVE

(TO PATRICK)

What are you doing?

PATRICK

(STARING AT A STORE ADVERTISEMENT)

I'm studying the actual retail prices of products.

DAVE

I'm going to regret asking this, but why are you doing that?

PATRICK

(TO DAVE)

Well, I thought it would be a good idea to figure out prices of products so I can win!

DAVE

Ok, that sounds weird. The prices of those products are different on the west coast.

What do you mean? They are the same everywhere!

DAVE

Ok, here...let me quiz you.

PATRICK

Alright.

(DAVE GRABS A STORE ADVERTISEMENT AND LOOKS AT IT)

DAVE

How much is a can of peaches?

PATRICK

Depends, do you want to know how much they are at a grocery store, a supermarket, or at a convenience store?

DAVE

(TO PATRICK)

Does it really matter?

PATRICK

(TO DAVE)

Yes, because the prices are different.

DAVE

(LOOKING AT THE STORE ADVERSTISMENT)

Okay, a supermarket's price.

PATRICK

Are they on sale?

DAVE

(TO PATRICK)

Does that really matter?

PATRICK

Yes!

DAVE

No, they are not on sale.

PATRICK

Okay, now is the can under a brand name?

DAVE

(ANGRY) Forget it, I quit!

PATRICK

Alright, but when I win a brand new car for knowing the price of a can of peaches, don't be asking for a ride.

DAVE

Sure, whatever you say dude. When I win the car for guessing the price of a box of macaroni, don't come crawling to me!

PATRICK

Whatever! How much you want to bet that I will be a better contestant than you?

DAVE

Easy. Ten bucks says that if you even make it to contestant's row, you won't make it up on stage.

PATRICK

You're on!

(DAVE AND PATRICK SHAKE HANDS)

DAVE

We'll see who the better contestant is going to be!

(SFX: DOOR KNOCK)

TIFFINY

Hi Guys! What's going on?

(DAVE AND PAT STARE AT EACH OTHER. THEY DO NOT ACKNOWLEDGE TIFFINY OR KATIE.)

KATIE

(TO TIFFINY)

Oh, this can't be good.

TIFFINY

What's going on guys?

DAVE

(TO TIFFINY)

Well, Mr. Anal Retentive here thinks that he's a better contestant for "The Price Is Right."

PATRICK

(TO TIFFINY)

No, Mr. Genius here thinks that he knows it all when it comes to "The Price Is Right." He's afraid that I'll be a better contestant than him.

DAVE

(TO PATRICK)

Oh you're so full of it!

(TO DAVE)

Oh yeah? We'll see.

(TO KATIE AND TIFFINY)

Katie, Tiffiny, you're going
with us to be witnesses!

DAVE

(TO PATRICK)

Fine!

PATRICK

(TO DAVE)

Fine!

KATIE

What're you guys arguing about this for? You may not even get picked!

DAVE

(TO PATRICK)

Well, one of us will. So, when I'm up on the stage playing "Plinko," I don't want to hear your voice helping me.

(TO DAVE)

Well, who said you were going to be picked?

DAVE

(TO PATRICK)

Well, why would they pick you?

PATRICK

(PROUDLY) Cause I have been a loyal fan and true for 15 years.

DAVE

No, I mean, give me a good reason!

TIFFINY

Look, let's just go and have a good time at the show. Who knows what will happen!

DAVE

(TO PATRICK)

Fine!

(TO DAVE)

Fine!

TIFFINY

Fine! Now...let's go and see a movie.

DAVE

I'll go, but Mr. Price Is

Right might want to stay and

(IN A GIRLISH VOICE) study!

PATRICK

Whatever!

TIFFINY

(TO PATRICK)

Do you want to go?

PATRICK

(SHYLY) No, I have to study.

DAVE

(TO TIFFINY)

Told you.

TIFFINY

(TO DAVE)

Honey, let's just go to the

movies and leave Patrick

alone ok?

DAVE

No problem.

(TO PATRICK)

Have fun studying!

PATRICK

(TO TIFFINY)

What movie are you going

to see?

TIFFINY

"The Eyeball Eating Man

From Venus." It's a

horror movie.

PATRICK

(TO TIFFINY BUT POINTS AT DAVE)

Make sure you check his

diaper after the movie.

DAVE

Come on ladies, let's go!

(AS DAVE, TIFFINY, AND KATIE LEAVES, WE:)

FADE OUT

ACT TWO

SCENE A

INT. AIRPLANE - EARLY TUESDAY MORNING

(Dave, Patrick, Katie, Tiffiny, Flight Attendant)

(EVERYONE IS SITTING IN THEIR SEATS ON THE AIRPLANE AS A FLIGHT ATTENDANT COMES OVER TO DAVE)

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

Good Morning, Sir. Would you like a beverage?

DAVE

Absolutely, what do you have?

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

Well, we have soda, diet soda fruit juice, and vodka.

PATRICK

And I bet Dave doesn't know the actual retail price of any of those drinks.

DAVE

Oh, I'm sure I can...

(TO DAVE)

Alright, how much is that

can of soda?

(PATRICK POINTS TO THE SODA)

DAVE

50 cents.

PATRICK

I'll say 60 cents.

(TO FLIGHT ATTENDANT)

How much is it?

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

Guys, these drinks are free.

PATRICK

But what is the actual retail

price?

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

I would say about 55 cents.

DAVE

Ah ha! I am the better

contestant!

Hold it right there bucko!

We ain't even started yet!

You wait until we get on

"The Price Is Right!"

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

So, what will you have, sir?

DAVE

Well, I'll just have a vodka.

TIFFINY

(TO DAVE)

Honey, you know you can't have

vodka.

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

Um, sir, how old are you?

TIFFINY

He's eight-

(DAVE PUTS HIS HAND OVER TIFFINY'S MOUTH)

DAVE

I'm twenty-five.

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

May I see some ID sir?

DAVE

Why?

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

I am not allowed to serve alcohol to underage patrons.

DAVE

Look at me, do I look underage?

(FLIGHT ATTENDANT LOOKS AT DAVE WHILE PATRICK NODS HIS HEAD AT THE FLIGHT ATTENDANT)

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

I'm sorry sir, it will just be straight soda for you.

DAVE

(SCREAMS) Who told?

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

The elderly gentleman next to you.

PATRICK

I'm not elderly! I'm only

twenty-five.

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

Right, sir, and I'm happy to work here.

(FLIGHT ATTENDANT WALKS OFF)

DAVE

What a bitch!

But she's kinda hot,

though.

DAVE

She probably has three

or four kids!

PATRICK

Never stopped me before!

(PATRICK WALKS OFF, AND WE:)

CUT TO:

ACT TWO

SCENE B

INT. FLIGHT ATTENDANT'S KITCHENETTE (CONTINUOUS)

(PATRICK, FLIGHT ATTENDANT)

(FLIGHT ATTENDANT IS PREPARING DRINKS WHILE PATRICK WALKS IN)

PATRICK

Hey baby!

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

Excuse me, what are you doing here?

PATRICK

I noticed that you were staring at me when you asked for that kid's ID.

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

Excuse me?

PATRICK

Baby, you know we were meant for each other. This is our destiny. It's fate that has brought us together.

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

Ok, I'll make sure you stay off the alcohol as well.

PATRICK

Oh baby, who needs the people out there. I need you.

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

(MIND CHANGES, SMILES) Oh I need you too baby... come closer

(AS PATRICK REACHES CLOSER FOR THE FLIGHT ATTENDANT, WE CUT TO AN OUTSIDE SHOT OF THE AIRPLANE AND A SOUND EFFECT OF A SLAP AND A SCREAM)

(SFX: SLAP)

(SFX: SCREAM)

DAVE (O.C.)

(SARCASTICALLY) Yeah, Patrick's

the man!

to me...

FADE TO:

ACT TWO

SCENE C

INT. HOTEL ROOM - TUESDAY NIGHT

(Dave, Patrick, Katie, Tiffiny)

(EVERYONE IS SITTING ON THE SIDE OF THE BED NOTICING PATRICK'S BLACK EYE)

DAVE

(TO PATRICK)

That's one hell of a black eye you got there.

PATRICK

I know, you go and ask for a change in your drink order and they take it seriously!

TIFFINY

(TO PATRICK)

That's not what I heard. I heard that you tried to hit on the flight attendant and she just about killed you.

PATRICK

(TO TIFFINY)

Who told you?

TIFFINY

I heard it from Katie.

(PATRICK LOOKS AT KATIE)

KATIE

I heard it from the flight attendent herself.

PATRICK

(TO KATIE)

I'm telling you, she wanted
me! I went to change my
order and she pounced herself
on me!

KATIE

(TO PATRICK)

Since when does changing your order comes in the form of

(IMPERSONATING PATRICK, WALKING TO TIFFINY)

Hey babe...

(POINTS TO TIFFINY'S CHEST)

How are the twins?

(EVERYONE LAUGHS, EXCEPT PATRICK)

Oh sure, keep dancing on the

minefield!

(EVERYONE STOPS LAUGHING, TO TIFFINY)

And as for you, why don't you

just buck, buck, buck.

(DAVE LAUGHS AND POINTS, TIFFINY TURNS AROUND, DAVE STOPS AND BECOMES SERIOUS)

DAVE

You better watch it, Pat.

TIFFINY

(TO DAVE, TREATING DAVE AS A PUPPY)

That's my good whipped

boyfriend.

(TO PATRICK)

So, now what do we do?

PATRICK

(TO DAVE AND TIFFINY)

Well, we are in Los Angeles,

so let's do what the Los

Angeleans do!

DAVE

(TO PATRICK)

We could get arrested for rioting.

PATRICK

(TO DAVE)

No, I mean let's take a trip into town.

KATIE

But we have to be up before eight o'clock.

PATRICK

I'm not really tired, though.

TIFFINY

Patrick's right, let's go and enjoy Los Angeles.

DAVE

(TO TIFFINY)

Well you and Patrick can have a good time then.

TIFFINY

Okay, we can do that. I'll miss you.

(TIFFINY KISSES DAVE)

DAVE

I'll miss you too, have a good time.

(AS PATRICK AND TIFFINY LEAVES, WE:)

FADE TO:

ACT TWO

SCENE D

INT. HOTEL HALLWAY - LATER THAT NIGHT

(Patrick, Tiffiny)

(PATRICK AND TIFFINY WALK INTO THE HALLWAY INTOXICATED. PATRICK IS CARRYING TIFFINY SO SHE WILL NOW FALL DOWN. THEY BOTH ARE STAGGERING AND TRYING TO GET TIFFINY'S DOOR UNLOCKED.)

TIFFINY

(SLIRRED) Thanks for making me out...or taking me out on the town tonight.

(PATRICK TOUCHES TIFFINY'S SHOULDER)

PATRICK

No, Tiffiny, thank you for coming out with me. Did you have a good time?

TIFFINY

(TO PATRICK)

I had a great time. Now
I want a better time.

PATRICK

What do you mean?

(TIFFINY KISSES PATRICK)

Dave won't like this.

TIFFINY

(PUTS HER ARMS AROUND PATRICK)

What Dave doesn't know

won't hurt him now will it?

Come in here with me.

(AS TIFFINY PULLS PATRICK INTO HER ROOM, WE HEAR:)

PATRICK

(SCREAMS) Mommy!

(AND THEN WE:)

FADE OUT.

ACT TWO

SCENE E

INT. HOTEL HALLWAY - TUESDAY MORNING

(Dave, Katie)

(DAVE IS KNOCKING ON PATRICK'S DOOR, BUT THERE IS NO ANSWER)

DAVE

(KNOCKS) Patrick, come on!

We have to be at the show

in a half-hour.

(THERE IS STILL NO ANSWER)

Come on Patrick, you're

gonna miss everything!

(KATIE WALKS TOWARDS DAVE, TAPPING HIM ON THE SHOULDER)

KATIE

Dave, come here.

DAVE

What is it?

KATIE

Apparently, Patrick never

made it to his room last

night.

DAVE

(CURIOUS) What do you mean?

KATIE

Okay, Dave, don't jump off
the deep end...but he is in
Tiffiny's room.

DAVE

Oh I'm not jumping off the deep end, but I'm going to kill him!

(DAVE STARTS RUNNING TOWARDS TIFFINY'S DOOR)

(AS KATIE RUNS AFTER DAVE, WE:)

KATIE

Dave, stop being so irrational.

CUT TO:

ACT TWO

SCENE F

INT. TIFFINY'S ROOM (CONTINUOUS)

(Dave, Katie, Tiffiny, Patrick)

(PATRICK AND TIFFINY ARE SLEEPING IN THE BED WHEN THEY HEAR KNOCKS ON THE DOOR)

PATRICK

(WAKES UP) What was that?

TIFFINY

(MUMBLES) Nothing honey, get

back to sleep.

(DAVE BREAKS IN THROUGH THE DOOR, PATRICK AND TIFFINY SIT STRAIGHT UP COVERING THEMSELVES WITH THEIR BLANKET)

DAVE

(TO PATRICK)

You bastard!

PATRICK

(TO DAVE HOLDING HIS HANDS UP)

Dave, calm down, this

isn't what it seems like.

DAVE

Isn't what it seems like?

You and my girlfriend are

naked in a bed, and your

breath smells like alcohol?

PATRICK

Okay, it does seem like it.

TIFFINY

(TO DAVE)

Dave, calm down. Don't hurt

him, he's your friend.

DAVE

(TO TIFFINY)

Wrong. He was my friend.

Tiffiny, I want you out of

that bed, cause you're coming

with me.

(TO PATRICK)

May God have mercy on your

soul!

KATIE

(TO DAVE)

Dave, that's not fair.

DAVE

(TO KATIE)

He slept with my girlfriend,

is that fair?

(TO PATRICK)

I thought I could trust you.

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(DAVE WALKS OUT OF ROOM, TIFFINY FOLLOWS)

KATIE

(TO PATRICK)

Why, Patrick, why?

PATRICK

I...I...don't know.

(AS PATRICK LEAVES, WE:)

FADE OUT.

ACT THREE

SCENE A

INT. "THE PRICE IS RIGHT" SET

(Dave, Patrick, Tiffiny, Katie, Bob Barker, Rod Roddy)

(DAVE, PATRICK, TIFFINY, AND KATIE ARE SITTING IN THEIR SEATS AT THE STUDIO.)

PATRICK

(TO DAVE)

Dude, I'm still sorry about

what happened.

KATIE

(TO PATRICK)

This isn't the best time to

talk to him.

TIFFINY

(TO DAVE)

Wow honey, look at this studio!

DAVE

(TO TIFFINY)

This does look bigger than

on television.

(ROD RODDY COMES OUT TO THE AUDIENCE FOR WARM UP)

ROD RODDY

Welcome everyone to "The Price Is Right!"

(AUDIENCE CHEERS)

This is going to be a special taping, because of the Bake-off that will be on the same day.

I'll call down two people to play two games and then go directly to the showcase. So, let's get started.

(ROD SITS AT HIS POSITION, AND "THE PRICE IS RIGHT" THEME STARTS TO PLAY)

DAVE

Uh oh! It's my song!

(STARTS DANCING)

Get Down! It's my birthday!

ROD RODDY (O.C.)

And now the star of "The Price
Is Right!" Bob Barker!

(BOB WALKS OUT FROM HIS DOORS)

PATRICK

It's him!

Thank you. This is a special edition of "The Price Is Right!"

We are going to pick two people to play two pricing games and then go off to the showcase. No showcase showdown today, sorry.

(TO ROD RODDY)

Rod?

ROD RODDY (O.C.)

Yes, Bob?

BOB BARKER

Who are our two special contestants for today?

ROD RODDY (O.C.)

Well, Bob, it is Patrick LaGrave and Dave Lightfoot, Come on down!

You are the two contestants for this special "Price Is Right!"

TIFFINY

(SCREAMS) Oh no!

DAVE

I hope your ready, (SARCASTICALLY)
buddy!

(DAVE AND PATRICK RUNS UP ON STAGE)

BOB BARKER

Congratulations for being up here on this special episode.

PATRICK

Thanks Bob. I want to say hi to my mom in Indianapolis.

DAVE

(TO PATRICK)

Will you shut up?

BOB BARKER

(TO DAVE)

That wasn't very nice, Dave.

PATRICK

(STANDS NEXT TO BOB, VERY PROUD)

Yeah, Dave...that wasn't very nice.

DAVE

(TO BOB BARKER)

Well, Bob, I'm sure it wasn't nice of him to sleep with my girlfriend last night either!

PATRICK

I already told you I was sorry.

BOB BARKER

You know what...this isn't the

Jerry Springer show, so let's

play some games!

(TO DAVE)

Dave, you can start first.

(TO ROD)

And what do we have for him, Rod?

(CUT TO THE PRICE IS RIGHT DOORS, WHICH OPEN, REVEALING TWO NICE GIFTS)

ROD RODDY

It's a nice armoire. From

Armoires and More, it's a

beautiful new Saint Patrick

Armoire with solid pine front

to back wrap around doors and

bottom pull out with file drawer.

Also a nice piano keyboard.

(AUDIENCE CLAPS)

From Yamaha, the new Yamaha P80, so sleek and easy to use, it makes music fun, from Yamaha.

Okay, Dave, we are going to play "Switch?" We have the Armoire priced at \$995 and the keyboard priced at \$1500. The object is to figure out if those prices are correct as they are, or if they should be switched?

(DAVE LOOKS INTO THE AUDIENCE)

DAVE

Bob, I think I want to switch.

BOB BARKER

Okay, the prices will be switched.

(THE MODELS SWITCH THE PRIZES)

Is he correct?

(SFX: DING)

He is, and you win!
Congratulations!

(DAVE WALKS AWAY, TO PATRICK)

Patrick, it is your turn to play.

PATRICK

I'm ready Bob.

BOB BARKER

Rod, what are his prizes?

(CUT TO THE PRICE IS RIGHT DOORS, WHICH OPEN, REVEALING TWO NICE GIFTS)

ROD RODDY

It's an entertainment center. This beautiful entertainment center comes with pocket doors, punch-out back panel, cable ready, reinforced TV shelf holds 35-inch and has VCR space under TV. One pull-out media storage tray that holds up to 66 CDs, 30 video tapes or 30 audiocassettes. One adjustable/removable storage shelf behind lower door, adjustable levelers from OnlyLeather.com. Also, you can win a new 35 inch high definition television set. From Zenith, it has picture in picture and remote control, Bob?

(TO PATRICK)

That's a nice prize don't you think?

PATRICK

Yeah, Bob.

(BOB AND PATRICK ARE STANDING IN FRONT OF "SQUEEZE PLAY" THE NUMBERS SHOWN ON THE BOARD ARE 3,7,5,3, AND 5)

BOB BARKER

Now, we are going to play "Squeeze Play." The object of this game is to...

PATRICK

Yes, Bob, I know, to pick
a number that is not in the
price of the prize.

BOB BARKER

You are good! The first number is 3, and the last number is 5. now you must pick whether or not the seven, five, or three is not right.

PATRICK

Easy, I'll pick seven.

Why is that?

PATRICK

Entertainment centers and

televisions are very cheap.

(Dave, Patrick, Bob Barker, Rod Roddy)

(PATRICK AND DAVE ARE STANDING BEHIND TWO PODIUMS READY TO PLAY THE SHOWCASE. BOB BARKER IS STANDING OUTSIDE OF THEM)

BOB BARKER

As quick as that, it is showcase time here on "The Price Is Right!" You all remember our two contestants, Dave and Patrick, who will bid On some lovely prizes. Dave, as the first place winner, you can either decide to bid on this showcase or pass it on to Patrick.

(NIKKI APPEARS SHOWING OFF A LARGE BILLBOARD THAT SAYS "NEW YORK" ON IT)

(CUT TO A PICTURE OF THE OMNI BERKSHIRE HOTEL)

You and your guest will spend
a five-day, four night
vacation in the suites of the

And while in New York, you and your guest will be able to take dancing lessons courtesy of the Manhattan Dance Project.

(CUT TO PATRICK)

PATRICK

(BOB BARKER QUIETS PATRICK DOWN, SO THE SHOWCASE CAN CONTINUE.)

ROD RODDY (O.C.)

At the Manhattan Dance Project,
You can learn the entire basic
disco techniques you need to get
Out there and dance! This
showcase, based from the movie
"Saturday Night Fever," can be
yours if "The Price Is Right!"

(CUT TO BOB, DAVE, AND PATRICK)

BOB BARKER

(TO DAVE)

Okay, Dave, there you go, would you like to bid or pass?

DAVE

Well, that sounds like a wussy showcase, so I'll pass it to Patrick.

PATRICK

Dave, that is not fair. I have apologized to you for that.

(CUT TO A PICTURE OF SPEEDWAY MOTEL-HOTEL)

(CUT TO A SHOT OF THE DOORS)

(CUT TO DAVE AND PATRICK'S FACE. DAVE IS EXCITED, WHILE PATRICK'S SHOWS A FLABBERGASTED LOOK)

The new 2002 Dodge Viper.

Once you experience this exotic roadster, with it's wildly strong 450-horsepower V10, anti-lock brakes, and California emission, you'll understand why it's called a "Viper." This showcase, a tribute to the Indianapolis 500, can be yours

BOB BARKER

Alright Dave, there is your showcase—

if "The Price Is Right!"

PATRICK

Wow, that's your dream showcase, Dave! You should be a cinch to win it!

BOB BARKER

(TO DAVE)

So what is your bid?

DAVE

\$53,217.

(THE AMOUNT SHOWS UP ON HIS PODIUM)

BOB BARKER

There you go, and we'll see

their actual retail prices, after

this!

(AFTER BOB FINISHES, WE :)

FADE OUT.

(PATRICK AND DAVE ARE STANDING BEHIND TWO PODIUMS READY TO PLAY THE SHOWCASE. BOB BARKER IS STANDING OUTSIDE OF THEM)

BOB BARKER

Okay, Dave, in your showcase

you have placed a bid of \$53,217.

Dave, the actual retail price

of your showcase is...

(OPENS UP HIS CARD)

\$42,106. You're over.

I'm sorry.

(BOB BARKER WALKS OVER TO PATRICK)

PATRICK

(TO DAVE)

I thought you knew it by

heart?

DAVE

(TO PATRICK)

Well, it was a Dodge, I

figured as though it was a

B-M-W.

Patrick, you had a bid of \$24,378. Patrick, the actual retail price of your showcase is...

(READS FROM HIS CARD)

\$24,377. You went over by a dollar. I'm sorry.

DAVE

(TO PATRICK)

Patrick, you knew that by heart!
Why did you go over a dollar?

PATRICK

Mail Call.

DAVE

SHHH! Alex Trebek is about to

be introduced.

(PATRICK STANDS QUIETLY)

TV ANNOUNCER (O.C.)

Here's the star of "Jeopardy!"

Alex Trebek!

PATRICK

Okay, may I talk now?

DAVE

(TURNS OFF TELEVISION)

Sure Patrick. What's up?

PATRICK

Mail Call.

(PATRICK HANDS DAVE AN ENVELOPE)

DAVE

(EXCITED)

YES!

PATRICK

What is it?

DAVE

We got accepted into the Jeopardy!

College Tournament!

PATRICK

Awesome! I can't wait until I win

that tournament scholarship money!

DAVE

Who said you are gonna win?

(SFX: DOOR KNOCK)

KATIE

Hey guys!

TIFFINY

Hey Dave!

(DAVE AND PAT STARE AT EACH OTHER. THEY DO NOT ACKNOWLEDGE TIFFINY OR KATIE.)

KATIE

Oh no! Not again!

THE END
